

# Recycling 101: Don't Throw That Out!

All recycling in Lancaster County is Single Stream Recycling, meaning everything goes together in one bin.

**ALL FOOD/BEVERAGE CONTAINERS MUST BE RINSED OUT!**

Flourescent light bulbs contain hazardous material we cannot accept. Take them to the Household Hazardous Waste Facility at 1299 Harrisburg Pike, Lancaster PA.

Batteries do not go in the recycling bin OR the trash can! Put batteries in a clear Ziploc bag and place it on top of your trash can lid.

## Plastics

### Recyclable

All plastic bottles

All plastics that have a "neck" can be recycled.



### Examples

Milk jugs

Water bottles

Detergent jugs

Shampoo bottles

### Not Recyclable

Plastic bags: Drop plastic grocery bags off at your local grocery store, most have a recycling program.

## Glass

### Recyclable

Glass bottles and jars



### Examples

Drink bottles

Glass jars

### Not Recyclable

Mirrors

Window or auto glass

Glass cookware/bakeware



## Metal

### Recyclable

Aluminum & Iron food containers



### Examples

Drink and food cans

Pet food cans

### Not Recyclable

Coat hangers

Scrap Metal



## Paper

### Recyclable

Newsprint

Corrugated cardboard

Printer/copier paper



### Examples

Newspaper

Cereal boxes

Magazines

Catalogs

Telephone books

### Not Recyclable

Wax-coated paper
